PETITION TO ESTABLISH A CHAPTER OF THE SOCIETY OF PHI ZETA AT TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE

We, the undersigned members of the Committee to Establish a Chapter of the Society of Phi Zeta at Texas Tech University School of Veterinary Medicine (TTUSVM) hereby petition for a charter for the establishment of such a chapter.

As support for this petition the school has one class currently in the professional curriculum; a first-year class (Class of 2025) composed of 63 students, and an admitted class (Class of 2026) composed of 88 students. It is the intent of the school to thereafter admit 100 students per class.

The faculty of the school is composed of 41 members, 26 of whom are veterinarians (DVM or equivalent degree). At least 7 of this number have been active members of the Society of Phi Zeta at other institutions and will form the nucleus of the new chapter.

We have a copy of the Phi Zeta Constitution of the Eta Chapter at Texas A&M University and a copy of the By-Laws of the Sigma Chapter at Kansas State University. We plan to pattern our by laws after those of the Sigma Chapter, in accordance with the Constitution of Phi Zeta.


